Chanukah Candle Lighting Blessings

Hold the shamash in your right hand and recite the following blessings.

On the first night of Chanukah (or the first time on Chanukah you do this mitzvah), recite all three blessings. On all following nights, say only the first two blessings.



Ba-ruch A-tah Ado-nai E-lo-hei-nu Me-lech ha-olam a-sher ki-desha-nu be-mitz-vo-tav ve-tzi-va-nu le-had-lik ner Cha-nu-kah.

Blessed are You, Lord our G-d, King of the universe, who has sanctified us with His commandments, and commanded us to kindle the Chanukah light.

Ba-ruch A-tah Ado-nai E-lo-hei-nu Me-lech Ha-olam she-a-sa ni-sim la-avo-tei-nu ba-ya-mim ha-heim bi-zman ha-zeh.

Blessed are You, Lord our G-d, King of the universe, who performed miracles for our forefathers in those days, at this time.

Ba-ruch A-tah Ado-nai E-lo-hei-nu Me-lech Ha-olam shehechi-ya-nu ve-ki-yi-ma-nu ve-higi-a-nu liz-man ha-zeh.

Blessed are You, L-rd our G-d, King of the Universe, who has granted us life, sustained us and enabled us to reach this occasion.
